Whistleblower Policy

Reporting Concerns

Employees

Employees should first discuss their Concern with their immediate supervisor. If, after speaking with his or her supervisor, the individual continues to have reasonable grounds to believe the Concern is valid, the individual should report the Concern to the Director of Human Resources or the Compliance Officer. If the individual is uncomfortable speaking with his or her supervisor, or the supervisor is a subject of the Concern, the individual should report his or her concern directly to the Director of Human Resources or the Compliance Officer. If the employee does not feel comfortable speaking with the Director of Human Resources or the Compliance Officer, the employee may report the matter directly to the Chair of the Audit Committee. Employees may also report their concerns anonymously through the Audit and Accounting Values Line toll free number. Contact information for the Director of Human Resources, the Chair of Audit Committee, and the Audit and Accounting Values Line are maintained on the shared intranet site.
